A.D. Write out "left ear", "right ear", or "both ears A.S. A.U. iu Write out "international units" MgS04 Write out magnesium sulfate MS04 Write out morphine sulfate 0.S. O.D. Do not abbreviate any medications

Write out mcg or microgram for all Levothyroxine orders instead of milligram.

Do not use terminal zeros for doses expressed in whole numbers (2.0 should be expressed at 2 mg).

Always use a leading zero before a decimal when the dose is less than a whole unit (.2 mg should be expressed as 0.2 mg).
